Language Arts:

This week we'll continue working on your One Story. You'll have a first draft due on Thursday. We'll be sharing them in class with a small group of your classmates and getting feedback that you'll use to write your second draft. We'll also discuss the reading requirements for 7th grade in more detail and you'll have some work to do to get on track to meet those expectations.
