Math:

Our NYC project will start with a class discussion about how we are going to solve a few problems. There are a few things we all need to decide before groups set about making a plan for how they are going to get their maps, scale drawings, and the plan for your 3D printed building done. Then we will break into our groups and start making maps! Goal work this week will be geared towards integers and you will get a packet of problems to work on and a typed copy of the integer rules. Homework will depend on how efficient you are during goal work time and how well your group works together.

SCIENCE:

This week in science we will begin our next unit which is on LIGHT ENERGY. Students will learn about the properties of light (how it travels, what happens when it encounters a different medium, etc.). Students will learn all about the different parts of the electromagnetic spectrum. This is a short unit, only a couple weeks long. Unit test in early February!!

HOMEWORK:

Each day during this unit- share one "light" fact around the dinner table that you learned from our light unit during school!!

Social Studies:
