Math:

On Monday and Tuesday we will be reviewing for the Algebra Unit Test and the Number System Unit Test. Here are the topics to refresh your memory: Algebra: Single Variable Equations – one solution, infinite solutions, no solutions, single variable inequalities – remember to reverse the inequality symbol when you multiply or divide by a negative, Two variable equations (linear relationships) – find the slope, y-intercept, table, graph, equation, from a table, graph, or equation, also identify variables and write an equation from a “real life” situation and explain what the slope, y-intercept, x-intercept mean. The tests will start on Wednesday and when you finish one, start the other.

SCIENCE:
